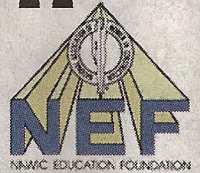


NAWIC's MAGIC CAMP

MENTOR A GIRL IN CONSTRUCTION

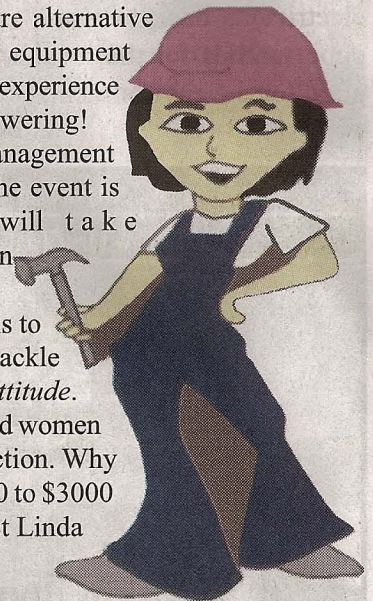
June 17-26, 2009
